

1. Introduction

International trade is the exchange of goods and services between nations. It enables a nation to specialize in those goods it can produce most cheaply and efficiently. Moreover, trade enlarges the potential marker for the goods of a particular economy. 2. Concepts and Definitions

Imports: - Are goods entered at the time of importation for consumption or warehousing into Ethiopia. including goods which are subsequently re-exported or re-directed.

Re-Exports: - Are imported goods subsequently re-exported without change of form, including ships or aircraft's stores.

Exports: - Are Ethiopian products, including imports which are exported after being transformed, improved or repaired.

Trade Balance: The total Exports plus Re- Exports minus total Imports.

Country of Origin: - The importers are obliged to submit manufacturer's invoices with import declarations. Generally, the country of origin is then the country in which goods were grown or produced.

Country of Destination: - Is the country of final destination to the extent identifiable from records.
